Key Stage 2 SATs

The key stage 2 outcomes represent a significantly positive picture for the primary provision at Bournville academy. The academy has built upon the outcomes in 2022 and ensured that the performance of students in reading and writing remains exceptionally strong. Maths outcomes represents a doubling of the attainment from 2022 which is reflected by an 'in line' rather than negative progress score. Further improvements in maths still remain a focus for the academy.

The key stage 1 outcomes are exceptionally strong at Bournville. The proportion of students meeting the expected standard is higher than the pre-covid national averages which shows the impact of the work that has been completed by staff with these students. The primary leaders are ensuring that the best practice in the KS1 teaching is being shared more widely and have adapted plans for the KS2 teaching to reflect the strengths of the student cohort.

Phonics Year 1 & Year 2 Retakes

The phonics outcomes in key stage 1 are strong. The proportion of children passing the Year 2 phonics retakes is higher than National Average displaying the intense support provided to children who need to catch up in reading. With a particularly small cohort, the Year 1 phonics scores highlight good outcomes as well, above National for this current year however, we aim to be back in line with pre-covid National scores.
