Maths	PSHE
Create a tally chart to show the differences and similarities between the members of your family. For example, tally how many people have brown eyes, green eyes, curly hair etc.	Draw a flower and in the middle draw a picture of yourself. Add some petals and on each petal write or draw one thing that makes you special and unique.
Art Ask your family to save different types of re-cycling such as kitchen rolls, straws, cheese triangle packets and tinfoil. Use the packaging to create a collage or a model of a boy, a girl or your favourite animal.	Design Technology Design a new toy for a pet cat, dog or rabbit. Think about what will make the toy special so that a pet would enjoy playing with it.

Ask all your family to draw around their handspan or their foot. Put them in order to see which one is the biggest and which one is the smallest. Does their handspan or foot size match their age or height? (e.g. is the person with the biggest handspan the tallest or the oldest person in the family?) Choose one of your favourite animals. With an adult, use the internet or a book to find out where in the world your favourite animal lives. Look up where they live on a world map. Remember some animals only live in one ot two countries and others live all around the world.
