RE: Visit to Cadbury Technical Kitchen, Bournville

We would like to invite your child to visit the Cadbury Technical Kitchen in Bournville on Friday 7th March to expand on your child's technical knowledge of a kitchen and sensory analysis skills. Your child has chosen GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition, and we would love for them to have the opportunity to expand their skills and knowledge in this area.

The trip will take place from 9.30am-3:00pm on Friday 7th March, so students will be in school for form time then out for the rest of the day. Students will be accompanied with two members of staff.

We recommend that students bring a drink and a coat. Lunch is kindly being provided by Cadbury, so please provide Miss O'Donnell with any dietary requirements.

Payment:

If you wish for your child to take part in this visit, payment can be made by debit or credit card online via ParentPay. Unfortunately, we can no longer accept cash or cheques in school. The reply slip will need to be returned to Miss O'Donnell. The cost will be £9.

To pay for the trip, log in to your child's ParentPay account. The trip name will appear in 'Pay for other items'. Then click 'View details and pay'. When you have added the trip to your basket, click 'Pay now'. You will then be able to pay securely by credit or debit card. ParentPay will open on Wednesday 22nd January, at 3pm and the deadline for payments is Monday 24th February, at 8am. If you don't have your ParentPay login details, please ask your child to collect a letter from Mrs. Jones in Elgar reception.

Places on the visit are subject to the exemplary behaviour and attendance of your child as an ambassador of Bournville School. Any breach in behaviour prior to the visit may result in your child being removed from the trip.

If your child has any medical conditions that require medication (e.g. asthma inhalers), they must have this with them on the day of the trip.
